Subject: Adopt Resolution No. __-2010 Supporting the Findings of the California Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment. A recently completed study concluded that the condition of local streets and roads (those not part of the California State Highway system) will deteriorate into “poor” condition in the next ten years, if funding levels remain constant over those ten years

Request

Adopt Resolution __-2010, supporting the findings that local streets and roads statewide will deteriorate into an average of “poor” condition in ten years at current funding levels, while Moraga roads will deteriorate to almost “very poor” condition in the same ten years at current funding levels.

Background

Staff presented information at the February 24, 2010 regular Town Council meeting regarding the condition and funding concerns for local streets and roads throughout the State of California, including specific information about the Town of Moraga.
