THIS MEETING WILL BE CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDERS N-25-20 AND N-29-20, WHICH SUSPEND CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF THE BROWN ACT, AND PURSUANT TO THE ORDERS OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF CONTRA COSTA COUNTY INCLUDING THE MOST RECENT ORDER DATED DECEMBER 16, 2020, WHICH IMPLEMENTS THE BAY AREA REGIONAL STAY AT HOME ORDER ISSUED BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH ON DECEMBER 3, 2020 AND MODIFIED ON DECEMBER 6, 2020, AND OTHER SUBSEQUENT ORDERS, WHICH PERMIT THE TOWN TO CONDUCT ESSENTIAL BUSINESS AND IS PERMITTED UNDER THE ORDERS AS AN ESSENTIAL GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION

Consistent with Executive Orders Nos. N-25-20 and N-29-20 from Governor Gavin Newsom and the Contra Costa County Health Officer Orders including the most recent dated December 16, 2020 implementing the Bay Area Regional Stay at Home Order issued by the California Department of Public Health, the January 13, 2021 regular meeting will not be physically open to the public. Town Councilmembers and essential Town staff will be teleconferencing into the meeting via Zoom.
