
12. TOWN MANAGER FOLLOW-UP AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

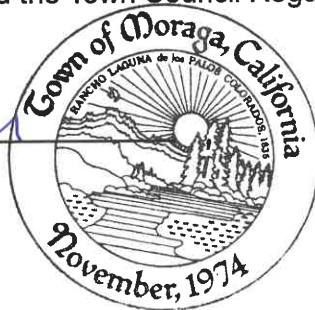
13. ADJOURNMENT
