Housing Element 2023-2031

Moraga's Housing Element is a critical component of the Town's General Plan that serves as the policy to guide the future of housing in the Moraga Community. The State of California mandates that the Housing Element is updated every eight years. The Town is now updating the Housing Element for 2023 - 2031. The State has determined that the Bay Area region must plan for an additional 444,176 new housing units, of which Moraga's allocation is 1,118.



Moraga's Housing Element and General Plan describe the type of community Moraga wants to be in the future and sets goals, policies and action programs to help achieve those goals. The current Housing Element identifies opportunities, challenges, and resources associated with housing through the [2015 - 2023 Housing Element](#) one of the seven mandated elements of the adopted [2002 General Plan](#).

BOLLINGER CANYON SPECIAL STUDY AREA

The Town Council is scheduled to receive a report and provide direction to staff on a General Plan

Amendment and Rezone of the Bollinger Canyon Special Study Area at the February 9, 2022 Town Council meeting. Zoning determines, among other things, what type and amount of development can be allowed on a parcel. This project is a Town Council goal and part of the Comprehensive Advanced Planning Initiative to update the Housing Element, complete an Environmental Impact Report, and Rezone parts of Town.

HETFIELD ESTATES PROJECT - APPROVED

On February 1, the Planning Commission approved the Hetfield Estates Subdivision, a 7-Unit Single Family Residential Development for grading, landscaping and design. The new subdivision is located between Larch Avenue, Sanders Drive and Sanders Ranch Road. The project has been in development since 2012 when the Conceptual Development Plan and EIR were originally approved.
