TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS ON JANUARY 25, 2023

COMPREHENSIVE ADVANCED PLANNING INITIATIVE / HOUSING ELEMENT

Town Council approved the Comprehensive Advanced Planning Initiative (CAPI) which will benefit residents by creating a vibrant, attractive, walkable town with amenities. The new 1,118 regional housing needs allocation will focus the redevelopment in the Moraga Center and Rheem Park areas, while allowing the Town to preserve existing neighborhoods and open space. It will allow a better mix of housing for seniors, first time home buyers, young families and those that work in Moraga to live in Moraga. Saint Mary's College and Moraga schools will be able to attract and retain staff who have long commutes. Staff and consultants will continue to do public outreach and work on wildfire, evacuations and mitigating traffic. View the [staff report](#) and [PowerPoint presentation](#).

CLEAN WATER PROGRAM (NPDES) ASSISTANCE CONTRACT

The Council awarded a Professional Services Agreement for Engineering Services for National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit Implementation Assistance to Kennedy & Associates (Walnut Creek, CA). The Town regulates all discharges into the storm drain system through a permit from the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB).

MORAGA ROAD AND HACIENDA DRAINAGE PROJECT COMPLETE

The Council accepted the \$217,418 in storm drainage repair completed by Kerex Engineering, Inc. (Martinez, CA) for the CIP 21-203 project and authorized the Interim Town Manager to record the acceptance with the County as required. This work included repairing severe pipe deficiencies along three storm drain pipe segments underlying portions of; 1) Hacienda de las Flores parking lot entryway (12-inch diameter CMP); 2) Hacienda de las Flores overflow parking lot adjacent to Donald Drive (60-inch diameter CMP); and 3) Moraga Road under street crossing near Corliss (24-inch diameter CMP). TOWN COUNCIL APPOINTMENTS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO COMMITTEES

The Town Council formally adopted the proposed list of Town Council appointments for 2023 to various Ad Hoc and Standing Committees, Commissions and Boards, as well as Town representatives to various local/county/state agencies.

COUNTY AMBULANCE ORDINANCE ADOPTION

The Town Council approved an Ordinance to adopt the Contra Costa County Emergency Medical Services Ordinance by reference. This addition creates uniformity with the County and other cities in ensuring that ambulances are operated safely and in accordance with established standards and allowing the Contra Costa County Emergency Medical Services Agency to enforce the updated Ordinance within the Town of Moraga.
