UPDATE FROM MORAGA TOWN STAFF

PG&E GAS PIPELINE REPLACEMENTS

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) will be replacing natural gas equipment, piping, and upgrading gas meters on Country Club Drive, Sandringham Drive, and Glen Alpine Street. Work will help enhance natural gas safety and reliability for the neighborhood. Work is expected to start on July 24th and continue through January 31st. Weather and other factors may affect and change their construction schedule, without notice. You may hear a loud, steady noise, and notice the smell of gas. This is normal while crews are working. The work should not interrupt gas services in the neighborhood. Driveway access may be affected for short period of times, but access can be provided upon request with PG&E. MORAGA LIBRARY CLOSURE

The Moraga Library will be closed beginning on Saturday, July 29 for an interior improvement project that includes several areas of the library. The project is expected to take approximately 10 weeks and the library is scheduled to reopen on Tuesday, October 10. Improvements to the library include new carpeting, relocating, and replacing the service desk, a new lounge area and marketplace, and resetting the bookshelves to improve accessibility. The refresh will also include new furniture in several areas of the library. The last day to place new holds for pickup at the library is Sunday, July 23. The book drop will be locked and holds will not be available for pickup during the closure. Library materials not picked up by the end of the day on Friday, July 28 can be collected when the library reopens on Tuesday, October 10. The hold period will be extended an extra week to October 17. During the closure, patrons may place holds online and pick them up at the Lafayette or Orinda libraries or any other Contra Costa County Library. Funding for the project is provided by the Town of Moraga and the Friends of the Moraga Library. The Friends contributed nearly \$90k in support of the refresh. Additional contributions from Moraga resident Mr. Robert Muller and the Stankus Family also helped to make the project possible.
