TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS ON FEBRUARY 28, 2024

AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH HARRIS AND ASSOCIATES

Town Council adopted a resolution approving the Sixth Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with Harris and Associates for the 2022 and 2023 Pavement Rehabilitation Projects.

ADDITION OF ONE FULL-TIME SENIOR ENGINEER POSITION AND REVISING THE SENIOR AND ASSOCIATE ENGINEER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Town Council adopted a resolution revising two Engineering job titles from Associate Civil and Senior Civil Engineer to Associate Engineer and Senior Engineer, the resolution also revises the job description to include a Traffic Engineer registration issued by the CA State Board of Traffic Engineering as a qualified license. Lastly, Town Council voted to authorize one additional full time Senior Engineer position as well as an amendment to the FY 23-24/24-25 budgets to reallocate staff vacancy savings to pay for the salary and benefits for the new Sr. Engineer position.

[Central Contra Costa Transit Authority Advisory Committee](#)

The Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) maintains a standing Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) to provide citizen perspective, participation and involvement in the CCTA's \$3 billion voter-approved Transportation Expenditure Plan and Growth Management Program. The CAC is comprised of 23 members: 20 are appointed by each of the 20 local jurisdictions within Contra Costa (the cities, towns, and the County); three "at-large" members are nominated by community-based stakeholder organizations within Contra Costa, and subsequently appointed to the CAC by CCTA. **This is a highly visible and topical Committee, especially in our busy County!**

[Local Sales Tax Oversight Committee](#)

One of the key elements of Measure K, Moraga's Local Sales Tax Measure, is the creation of an objective third-party oversight committee. Although the funds are considered a general tax and could, in theory, be spent on any municipal activity, the Town Council and the organizers of Measure K all stated that the funds would only be spent to repair the Town's roads. This committee is therefore tasked with ensuring the funds are spent as promised. **Have an interest in how your government spends its money; this is the place for you!**

[Park and Recreation Commission](#)

The Commission is responsible for reviewing the Master Plans for the parks and making necessary recommendations to the Town Council. They operate in accordance with established rules and procedures for Town Government meetings. **Who loves trees; we do! Apply to be a part of an important Commission supporting the future of our parks and open space in Moraga!**

[Planning Commission](#)

The Planning Commission is responsible for reviewing, evaluating and deciding land use applications in accordance with the Town's land use policies and zoning regulations. The Planning Commission also serves as the Design Review Board and is responsible for reviewing, evaluating and deciding applications for design review for new buildings, master sign programs and certain types of signs, projects requiring an exception to the Town's Design Guidelines, and projects located within a scenic corridor, in accordance with the applicable development standards and design guidelines. **Interested in the development process in your community, consider applying to the Planning Commission!**
