IMPLEMENTATION OF REVISED STREET REHABILITATION COST SHARING POLICY

Your Town Council held a public hearing and adopted an ordinance amending the Moraga Municipal Code to incorporate a Revised Street Rehabilitation Cost Sharing Policy.

Additionally, Staff will amend existing private property owner reimbursement agreements to allow for repayment of eligible sidewalk area repairs.

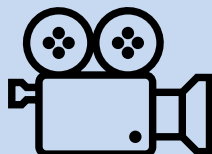

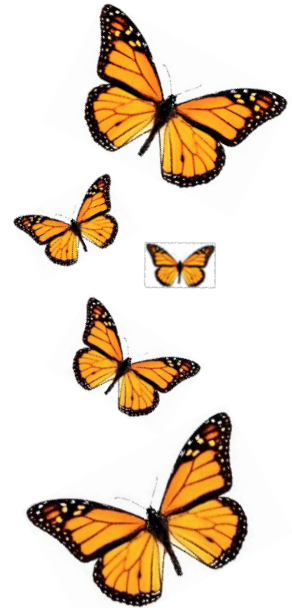

A mini poster gallery showing and artists' reception reinforces Moraga's commitment to ecology, beauty and community!

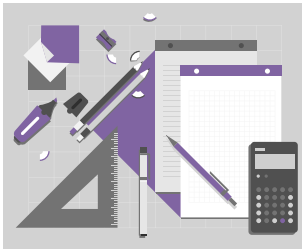

On Behalf of the Town of Moraga we thank our Administrative Professionals for their service to our Community!

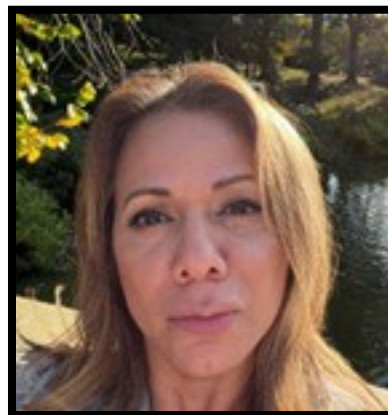
We wish to spotlight TWO of the Town's **SUPER-STAR** Administrative Professionals: **Suzie Mele** and **Jeanet Lara**!
