#### **PUBLIC HEARING: Ordinance Amending Moraga Center Specific Plan R-6 Zoning Mike McGill, Roger Bailey and Emily Barnett presented on behalf of Central Contra Costa Sanitary District**

In a 3-1 vote with Councilmember Shapiro being absent, Council voted to waive the first reading and introduce by title only an Ordinance amending Chapter 8.32 of the Moraga Municipal Code implementing Program 4(b) in the 2023-2031 Moraga Housing Element and amending the development standards in the Moraga Center Specific Plan (MCSP) Six Dwelling Units Per Acre Multifamily Residential District (MCSP R-6) to facilitate housing production.

## Moraga General Plan 2040 Update



The Town is encouraging all residents, business owners and property owners to attend the upcoming General Plan 2040 meetings. An important aspect of the General Plan is the Values and Guiding Principles which were initially discussed in October and November 2023 and will be updated in the new General Plan.

Staff have conducted over 16 community outreach, workshops and meetings to date on the General Plan. Going forward the Council will discuss the entirety of the General Plan including the Values and Guiding Principles.

The formal meetings will be held as follows:

- **August 28, 2024:** Focused discussion on the Transportation Element ✓
- **September 11, 2024:** Joint TC and PC Meeting with a Pre-view Draft of the entire General Plan
- **October 22, 2024:** Planning Commission Study Session on Draft General Plan
- **October 23, 2024:** Town Council Study Session on Draft General Plan
- **November 4, 2024:** Special Planning Commission Meeting on Final General Plan
- **November 13, 2024:** Town Council Meeting on Adoption of General Plan
