TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS ON OCTOBER 9, 2024

PROCLAMATION DECLARING OCTOBER 2024 AS COMMUNITY PLANNING MONTH

Town Council recognized October 2024 as Community Planning Month via a Proclamation. Planning Department Staff were in attendance to receive the Proclamation.

Townwide Street Rehabilitation Project Construction Contract Change Order

Town Council adopted a Resolution approving a change order authorizing an increase to the construction project's contingency budget by \$37,998 (10%) from \$534,617 to \$572,615 in support of Townwide street repair projects.

\$1,100,000 Safe Routes to Transit and Bay Trail Program Planning Grant Application

Town Council adopted a resolution to submit a \$1,100,000 "Safe Routes to Transit and Bay Trail" (SR2TBT) Planning Grant Application in partnership with the City of Orinda and Contra Costa County Transportation Authority.

Amendment to Town Council Protocol 3.1 – Selection of Mayor and Vice Mayor

Town Council voted to expand the criteria used for its annual selection of Mayor and Vice Mayor. In the past, Town Council based its selection primarily on the number of votes received by Councilmembers during the previous election. In order to accommodate situations where Councilmembers are appointed, and not elected, the protocol based on the number of votes received in the prior election was broadened to include the following factors: seniority, experience, leadership, willingness to collaborate, efficiency, and other relevant and legal factors. Town Council is still required each December to select a new Mayor and Vice Mayor with at least three affirmative votes to serve one-year terms. Each Mayor and Vice Mayor will remain ineligible to succeed themselves in the same office the following year.

Moraga General Plan 2040 Update



The Town is encouraging all residents, business owners and property owners to attend the upcoming General Plan 2040 meetings. An important aspect of the General Plan is the Values and Guiding Principles which were initially discussed in October and November 2023 and will be updated in the new General Plan.

Staff have conducted over 16 community outreach, workshops and meetings to date on the General Plan. Going forward the Council will discuss the entirety of the General Plan including the Values and Guiding Principles.

The formal meetings will be held as follows:

- **August 28, 2024:** Focused discussion on the Transportation Element ✓
- **September 11, 2024:** Joint TC and PC Meeting with a Pre-view Draft of the entire General Plan ✓
- **October 15, 2024: Planning Commission Study Session on Draft General Plan**
- **October 22, 2024:** Planning Commission Recommendation to Adopt General Plan
- **October 23, 2024:** Town Council Study Session on Draft General Plan
- **November 13, 2024:** Town Council Meeting on Adoption of General Plan
