Reorganization of the Town Council - Nomination and Election of Mayor and Vice Mayor

The Town Clerk gave the Oath of Office to incoming Town Councilmembers: Brian Dolan, Lisa Maglio and Graham Thiel.

Following the Oath of Office, Vice Mayor Woehleke presided over the remainder of the reorganization by first calling for a nomination for Town Council Mayor. Councilmember Hillis nominated Vice Mayor Woehleke. Vice Mayor Woehleke was elected Mayor by a 5-0 vote.

Newly elected **Mayor** Steve Woehleke called for a nomination for Vice Mayor. Councilmember Thiel nominated Councilmember Hillis for Vice Mayor and Councilmember Hillis was elected to Vice Mayor by a 5-0 vote. Thus, the 2024-2025 Town Council reorganization was complete.

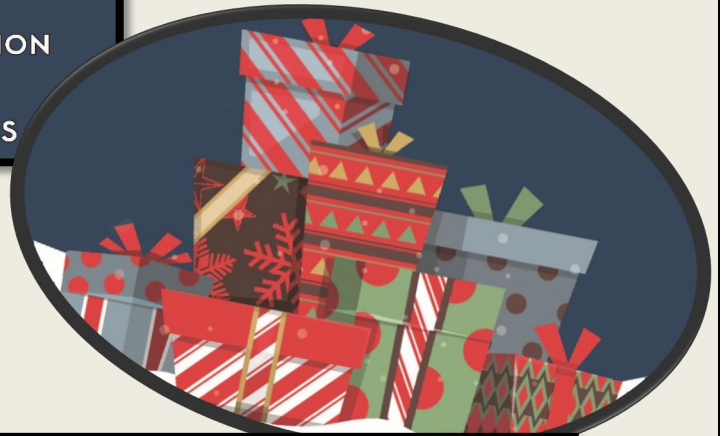

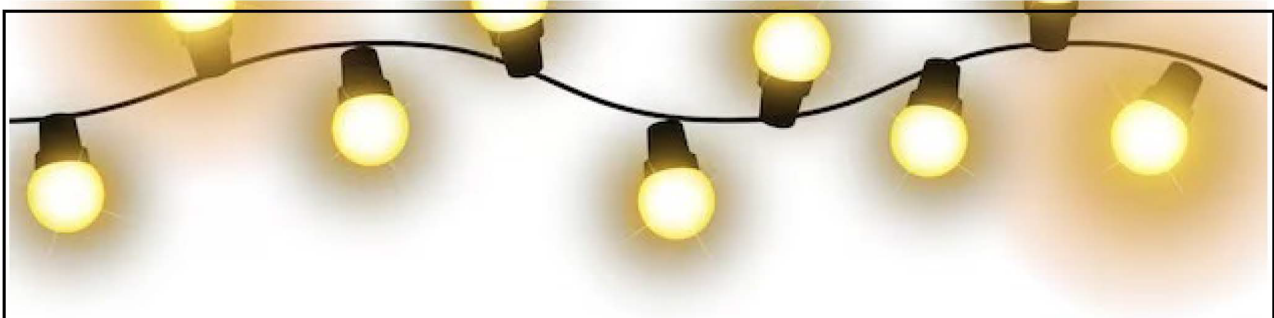
