TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS ON JANUARY 15, 2025

PUBLIC HEARING:

[Appeal of a 66 Unit Multi-family Residential Apartment Building Development located at 1600, 1640, and 1660 School Street \(including Five Very Low-Income Units\) Requiring Design Review \[DRB-07-22\], Grading Permit \[GR-04-22\], and Density Bonus Approvals](#)

Your Town Council adopted a resolution denying an appeal and upholding the Moraga Planning Commission's October 29, 2024 decision to approve the development project of a four story 66 unit multi-family residential apartment building, which includes five very low-income units located at 1600, 1640 and 1660 School Street. The decision to deny the appeal brought forward at the January 15, 2025 Town Council special meeting was unanimous at a 5-0 vote.

RE-OPENING OF THE LAFAYETTE-MORAGA REGIONAL TRAIL

On December 11, 2024, officials from the East Bay Regional Park District, EBMUD, and the Town of Moraga celebrated the reopening of a section of the Lafayette-Moraga Regional Trail, which had been closed since 2016 due to a landslide.

The newly reopened section, between Canyon Road and Westchester Street in Moraga, is part of the larger trail that stretches 7.65 miles between Lafayette and Moraga. The reopening is the result of a collaborative effort among the East Bay Regional Park District, EBMUD, and the Town of Moraga. The project included slope stabilization, trail reconstruction, and other improvements. In 2020, the Town of Moraga completed the Canyon Road Bridge Replacement Project, and in 2021, EBMUD finished the Moraga Creek Flood Control Project, both of which contributed to the trail's restoration.

Community leaders expressed their excitement, emphasizing the trail's importance as a recreational resource and a safe route to schools for local children.
