Parks Recreation and Open Space Commission

The Commission is responsible for reviewing the Master Plans for the parks and making necessary recommendations to the Town Council. They operate in accordance with established rules and procedures. The Park and Recreation Commission chairperson and vice chairperson are elected annually by the Commission at their March or April meeting.

ZONE ZERO INFO

What is Zone Zero, and why is it critical in wildfire prevention?

In February, Governor Gavin Newsom signed an executive order to accelerate the adoption of regulations requiring many California homeowners to create a 5-foot "ember-resistant" zone around their home. This area is known as **Zone Zero**.

With most homes lost to wildfires due to flying embers, keeping this area clear of combustible materials can dramatically reduce the chances of home ignition.
