Parks, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan



The Town of Moraga is updating its Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Master Plan. This is a community-wide 15-month effort to help Town Council determine which improvements to make to the Town's parks, trails, open spaces, recreation facilities, and programs/events. 
