

Augusta Drive Storm Drain Repairs - November 17th

The Town Council awarded FJ&I Engineering a construction contract for the Augusta Drive Storm Drain Repairs. **Construction is expected to begin on Monday, November 17, 2025, pending weather or site condition delays.** The project is located near the western corner of Augusta Drive & St. Andrews Drive. Work consists of roadway trench excavation, storm drain pipe replacement and repairs, and asphalt restoration.
