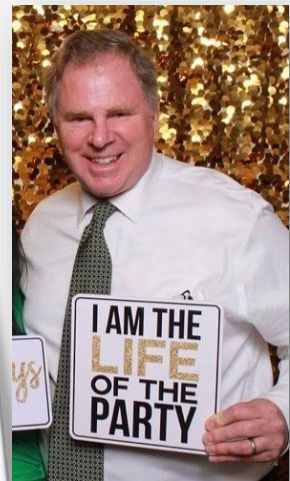

- **[Simple Energy-Smart Pro Tips](#)**: For most households, electricity rates are highest between 4 and 9 pm. Run major appliances earlier in the day to save money and use cleaner energy.



Clear Debris to Prevent Flooding Prior to Rain

"V" Ditch and Driveway Culvert Maintenance

Property owners are responsible for the concrete drainage swales on their property, known as "V" ditches. Proper "V" ditch care includes removal of debris and foreign objects, removal of vegetation that may obstruct flow, ensuring the ditch is structurally intact, and repair of ditch deficiencies.



Also, it is just as critical to maintain drainage culverts underneath your driveway in the same manner.
