TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS on January 14, 2026

Public Hearing

8A Town Council waived the second reading and adopted an ordinance repealing and replacing MMC Chapter 15.04 "Building Codes" of Title 15 and adopting by reference certain sections of Contra Costa County Ordinance No. 2025-19, which adopts the 2025 California Building Code, the 2025 California Residential Code, the 2025 California Electrical Code, the 2025 California Mechanical Code, the 2025 California Plumbing Code, the 2025 California Energy Code, the 2025 California Historical Building Code, the 2025 California Existing Building Code and the 2025 California Green Building Standards Code with changes, additions and deletions, with adoption of findings to justify stricter construction standards to address local climatic, geological, or topographical conditions as authorized by Health and Safety Code sections 17958.5 and 18941.5. 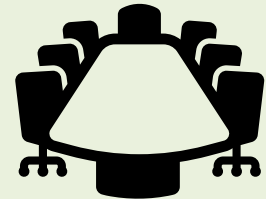

Federal Grant Awarded for Moraga Way Study

Moraga & Orinda Awarded \$508,000 Federal SS4A Grant for Moraga Way Study

The Town of Moraga, in partnership with the City of Orinda, has been awarded a **\$508,000** federal Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Planning and Development grant to advance the **Moraga Way Safety and Connectivity Planning Study**.

The planning study will evaluate the **4.7-mile Moraga Way corridor, from Moraga Road (Moraga) to the Orinda BART Station (Orinda)**.
