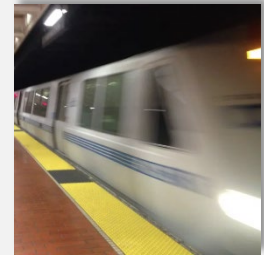

Proposed 2026 Lamorinda Legislative Framework

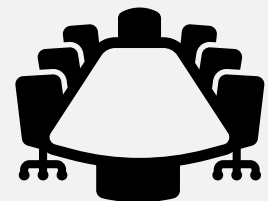
Town Council approved by minute order the Lamorinda Legislative Framework, which becomes the official legislative policy document for the three Lamorinda municipalities.

Kick off the new year with adventure!

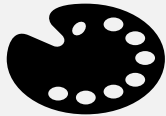
