VIRTUAL EVACUATION DRILL ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 30

The Lamorinda Police Departments, in cooperation with the Moraga-Orinda Fire District, Contra Costa County Fire and the Contra Costa County Community Warning System (CWS), will conduct a virtual evacuation exercise beginning at 8:00 am on Saturday, September 30. Messages will be sent to residents signed up for CWS text message or email notifications in all Lamorinda cities and to the community of Canyon sometime between 8:00 am and 9:30 am. Note: We are not initiating phone calls for this exercise. The purpose of the exercise is to test and refine the communication systems that will be used in the event an emergency evacuation is required. While we all hope an emergency evacuation will never be needed, preparing for the event is essential.



TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS ON SEPTEMBER 27, 2023

PROCLAMATION DECLARING OCTOBER AS BULLYING PREVENTION MONTH



The Town Council presented a proclamation declaring October 2023 as Bullying Prevention and Moraga iKind Project Month to Wendell Baker, Moraga's "Ambassador of Kindness." Wendell, from Moraga's iKind Project, encouraged all Moragans to join in prevention activities designed to promote civility and compassion and make the community and schools safer for all children and teenagers.

MORAGA MURAL PROJECT

The Town Council approved "Natural Beauty of the Surrounding Hills" as the theme for the Moraga Mural Program. After thoughtful analysis of the 221 survey results by the Art in Public Spaces Committee (APSC) Mural Subcommittee, this was the phrase most in alignment with responses. The next step is to issue the Request for Proposals (RFP) to the public. Applicants will submit information and a rendering based on how they interpret the theme/keywords. The artist will be chosen based on the aforementioned, as well as the budget. Once approved by the Council, APSC will commence fundraising for the mural. If and when funds are received, Council will approve a final mural design and the artist will be given permission to move forward. For more information, read the staff report [here](#).

AMENDED TOWN COUNCIL PROTOCOLS

The Town Council reviewed and approved an updated version of the Town Council Protocols. The finalized Protocols will be posted on the Town's website soon.

COMMONS PARK RESTROOM REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Town Council approved awarding a construction contract to McNabb Construction as the demo and installation contractor for the Commons Park Restroom Replacement Project in an amount not to exceed \$165,319. As part of this approval, Town staff requested an additional allocation of \$91,171 from Fund 250 – Park Dedication – Quimby Act for a total construction budget of \$560,171 for FY 2023-24. PG&E GAS PIPELINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Town Council approved a First Amendment to the Consulting Services Agreement with Coastland Civil Engineering, LLP for construction inspection services for the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) Gas Pipeline Replacement Project on Country Club Drive, Sandringham Drive North, Sandringham Drive South, and Glen Alpine Drive. PG&E applied for an encroachment permit to replace

their natural gas system equipment and upgrade underground gas mains and service connections to enhance natural gas safety and reliability within our community. For additional information, please see the [staff report](#).

MORAGA ROAD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Town Council approved a First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with CSG Consultants Inc. (CSG) of Pleasanton, CA, for the Moraga Road Drainage Improvement Project. CSG is developing the engineering plans to address localized flooding on Moraga Road. John Muir Land Trust's (JMLT) Painted Rock Open Space receives rainfall that flows towards Moraga Road, flooding the northbound lane between Dolores Court and Hansen Court. The project will improve the drainage at this location and mitigate potential flooding. For additional information, please see the [staff report](#).
