TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS ON OCTOBER 25, 2023

PILLARS OF SUPPORT ART SCULPTURE FOR RANCHO LAGUNA PARK

Town Council approved the donation of a sculpture, Pillars of Support, for Rancho Laguna Park from the Moraga Garden Club. The idea involves installing three wooden pillars (six, seven, and eight feet tall). Each pillar would be painted with illustrations of a monarch butterfly life stage (egg, larvae, or chrysalis) by Moraga artists, Teresa Onoda and Suzanne D'Arcy. Individual recognition plaques bearing the donor's name and year donated would be applied to the pillars once a donation is made to Moraga for Monarchs. Along with the sculpture, Moraga for Monarchs plans to create a native plant expansion in the same vicinity as the sculpture. The donations could potentially sustain Moraga for Monarchs for an additional 4-5 years.

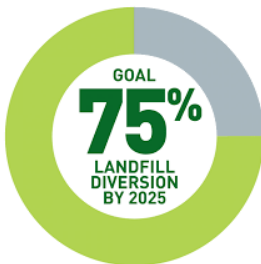


REMINDER ABOUT UNSOLICITED DONATION REQUESTS

Some unsolicited donation requests seek to take advantage of society's giving nature for financial gain. Unsolicited phone calls or mailers may appear legitimate on face value but warrant research by donors to ensure their legitimacy. Some things to look for: addresses and phone numbers on websites and mailers don't match, internet search results, and Better Business Bureau (BBB) search results. Additionally, the Moraga Police Department does not seek direct financial donations from the public.



DON'T FLIP YOUR LID! CALIFORNIA ORGANICS LAW SB 1383

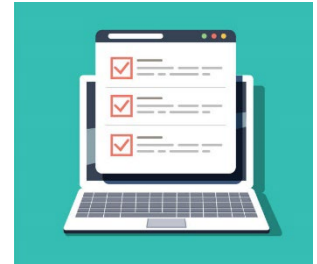


California law SB 1383 requires local jurisdictions to monitor contamination and proper sorting of organic waste by performing annual route audits. The week of November 10, inspectors with RecycleSmart will conduct visual 'lid flip' inspections of trash, recycling, and organics containers to ensure proper sorting, recycling, and landfill (residential and commercial) carts. RecycleSmart will not be imposing any fines or taking photos of the contents of the carts.
